Overview

LanguageCert International ESOL qualifications are designed to assess and certify English language proficiency for speakers of other languages. The qualifications are aligned with the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), covering levels from A1 (beginner) to C2 (proficient).

The course develops learners' skills in reading, writing, listening, and speaking, preparing them for academic study, professional environments, and everyday communication. These qualifications are widely recognised by educational institutions, employers, and government bodies worldwide.

Skills Assessed

- **Listening:** Understanding spoken English in various contexts.
- **Reading:** Comprehending texts, from everyday materials to more complex content.
- **Writing:** Writing clear, detailed texts on diverse topics.
- **Speaking:** Engaging in conversations on familiar topics with some fluency.

Exam Structure

- **Written Exam:** Tests Listening, Reading, and Writing skills through audio clips, reading texts, and writing tasks (emails, essays).
- **Spoken Exam:** A face-to-face interview with the examiner to assess speaking skills in a conversation.

Assessment Criteria

- **Listening and Reading:** Multiple-choice, gap-fill, and true/false questions.
- **Writing:** Assessed for content, grammar, punctuation, and coherence.
- **Speaking:** Assessed for fluency, accuracy, and pronunciation

Scoring and Grading

Each skill is scored separately, with grades ranging from A (excellent) to E (basic proficiency). A passing grade is typically C or higher.

Benefits

- **Recognition:** Accepted worldwide for academic, career, and immigration purposes.
- **CEFR Alignment:** Reflects real-life English skills.
- **Practical Application:** Designed to assess communication skills learners will use in daily life.





Assessment and Verification

Assessment Methodology

- **Written Exam:** Includes listening to audio clips, reading texts, and writing tasks.
- **Spoken Exam:** A face-to-face interview with the examiner.

Verification Process

- **Internal Verification:** Examiners check consistency in scoring.
- **External Verification:** Independent experts ensure international standards are met.

Quality Assurance

Regular reviews of materials, feedback, and examiner performance maintain exam quality.

Results Verification

Results are available through the LanguageCert online portal, typically within weeks.

Secure exam venues and remote proctoring ensure the integrity of the exam process.
